DCR Meeting Report

Bill Rideout, Steve Meehan, Bruce Easom, and Peter Cunningham met again with Commissioner Lambert on March 19. They summarized the outcome as presenting a path forward, but one that is more difficult.

Two issues that must be addressed are prevailing wage and a commitment from Townsend for maintenance if our group fails.

Bill Rideout has written a description of our position on prevailing wage and will get an opinion from the MA Department of Labor. Even if the opinion falls in our favor, the Commissioner may opt not to embrace it.

One suggestion for addressing the maintenance issue is a performance bond. Bruce Easom and other will research costs for trail maintenance in order to estimate the performance bond amount.

Bob Hargraves will contact Representative Sheila Harrington to help move along the Resor Amendment.

Grant Application

Our application to the Community Foundation of North Central Massachusetts is written and being reviewed. Since we don't have a draft agreement yet from DCR, we will attach a copy of our most recent letter from the Commissioner.

Directors Insurance
