Re: Abandonment of and Discontinuance of Service Greenville Branch Docket Nos.: AB - 1078X and AB - 1079

Ladies and Gentlemen:

The Boston and Maine Corporation and the Springfield Terminal Railway Company intends to file a Notice of Exemption with the Surface Transportation Board regarding the abandonment of an approximately 5.0 mile line of railroad known as the Greenville Branch in Ayer and Groton, Massachusetts. A map depicting the portion of the line to be abandoned is attached hereto.

In connection with the Notice of Exemption, federal regulations at 49 CFR § 1105.7 and § 1105.8 require that we prepare an Environmental/Historical Report after consulting with and gathering information from your office regarding the anticipated impact of the proposed action on environmental and historical resources.
